1)	Mary Magdalene is mentioned at least 12 times in the Bible, which is more than some of the apostles. Look at some of these references Matt. 27:56,61; Matt. 28:1, John 20:1
2)	Relate and discuss the events that took place in the Pharisee's house, and involved a "woman in the city, which was a sinner." Read/review Luke 7:36-50; Was this the Mary of our lesson? "Thy sins are forgiven." R 2200
3)	Along with the twelve disciples of Jesus, we have mention of certain women that followed them. What special event is mentioned involving Mary Magdalene in Luke 8:2? <i>R</i> 5370 What was her background?
4)	While many had forsaken our Lord Jesus, what was Mary Magdalene's desire or reaction to the events surrounding his crucifixion? Matt. 27:56, 57; Mark 15:40; (John 19:25; Mark 15:40,41) (Hint-Near the cross.)
5)	We are told that Mary Magdalene went to visit the tomb of Jesus early in the morning. Why was she going there? Mark 16:1-8; Matt. 28:1-6; Luke 23:56; Luke 24:1-9; Psalm 46:5
6)	Because of her faithfulness in following Jesus, what privilege was granted to Mary Magdalene? <i>Matt.</i> 28:1,2; 5-8; 9-10; John 16:7-11; R1816; Also see (John 20:14,18), She "saw Jesus standing, and knew not that it was Jesus." However, she soon recognized him when (John 20:11-16) Why?
')	What are some additional lessons that we can learn and apply from the life of Mary Magdalene? Mark 6:34; I Peter 3:8; Rom. 9:14,15; Rom. 12:1; Eph. 6:5-7; I Peter 2:17; I John 4:19; John 15:12,17; Isa. 26:3, 4; John 10:27; II Tim. 2:22; I Thess. 5:15
