1)	Where was David when he composed this Psalm and what was the occasion for him being there? Psalm 63:1, 2 Samuel 15:13-17
2)	In verse 1 praising God David says I will seek thee early. What do you suppose he is referring to?
3)	In verse 1, 5, 8 &9 David refers to "My Soul". Why do you suppose he uses this term and how is it applied in each instance? Is there a spiritual application to be applied to the New Creature? Verse 1- My Soul Thirsteth for Thee Verse 5-My Soul Satisfied as with marrow and fatness Verse 8- My Soul followeth hard after thee Verse 9- Seek My Soul, to destroy it
4)	David gives one (1) reason for praising God. What is it and how and when does he demonstrate his appreciation? Psalm 63:3,7.
5)	Referring to Question 4 what should the spirit begotten new creature do to show appreciation to God?
6)	How do we know that David knew he would be delivered from this experience and that he would prevail? Psalm 63:7-10, 2Samuel 15:24-30,
7)	David seems to feel there is value in meditation- What about today – is meditation valuable for us? How can we use meditation on the word of the Lord to increase our faith and praise? 2Peter 1:4, Psalm 40:8, Reprint 1390, Psalm 19 and comments, Psalm 1:2; 77:12; 119:15,16,24; Psalm 143:5; 119:97,104,111; 104:34.
