1. **1 Cor. 4:1,2** - What was Paul telling the brethren to consider Apollos and himself as being and how does this relate to how we should be? *Luke 19:11-27; Matt. 25:14-20; Isa. 61:1,2; 1 Peter 4:10*

2. **1 Cor. 4:3-5** - What does Paul say about judging one another, including himself and who should be the judge and why? *1 Cor. 11:31, Ecc. 3:17, Matt. 7:1,2,20, Luke 6:37, Rom. 2:1,16, Rom. 14:10,12,13, James 5:9*

3. **1 Cor. 4:6,7** - What was Paul trying to get across to the brethren using Apollos and himself as illustrations and how can this also be a warning for elders and deacons who preach the word of God? What does he mean, "Who maketh thee to differ"? *Rev. 22:9; 1 Tim. 3:6; 1 Cor. 1:12,13; 1 Cor. 3:4-7; Luke 18:11-14; 2 Cor. 3:5; James 1:22*

4. **1 Cor. 4:8-14** - How does Paul describe their behavior and how does he describe how faithful servants of God are viewed as by the world and by angels? *John 15:19,20; 1 Peter 5:3; 1 John 4:4-6; 1 John 3:1; Rev. 3:17,18;*

5. **1 Cor. 4:15,16** - What point is Paul trying to make the brethren understand? Who are we to follow? *Matt. 16:24; Acts 9:6,15,16; Acts 22:10,21; Rom. 1:16; Rom. 14:8,17,18; Rom. 15:14; Eph. 5:1*

6. **1 Cor. 4:17-21** - What is Timothy to help them with? What is the power of Christian living? *2 Peter 1:5; Rev. 2:10; Eph. 5:8-10; Phil. 1:27; Phil. 3:13,14*
