1. We realize that that the foundation of everything rests upon our dear Savior’s sacrifice. In the *very simplest of a few words*, what does the unleavened bread represent – and what does “the cup” represent? This is the PRIMARY significance of these emblems – but is there a SECONDARY significance to these emblems?
2. Read I Cor. 10:16-17 (Diaglott). Also Rom. 6:3, Col. 1:24,26, Heb. 3:1 with Lev. 16:11. What does the Apostle mean that we have become “participators” with our Lord in his death – have a participation in some way – in the blood and the body - “sharers” in his sacrifice?
3. Read I Col. 1:24 The Apostle Paul says that we “fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ”? How can that be?
4. I Cor. 12:12-14 What is the “real” communion with our Lord that the consecrated are privileged to share?
