1)Luke 1:77 To give knowledge(ST1108) of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins, KJV

**Luke 1:77** To give to His people the **knowledge** of salvation By the forgiveness of their sins, NASU

**Context:** Luke 1:67-80 Zechariah's Prophecy

2)Luke 11:52 Woe unto you, lawyers! for ye have taken away the key of knowledge:(ST1108) ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered. KJV

**Luke 11:52** Woe to you lawyers! For you have taken away the key of **knowledge**; you yourselves did not enter, and you hindered those who were entering." NASU

**Context:** Luke 11:45-54 Jesus Denounces Pharisees and Lawyers

3)Romans 2:20 An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge(ST1108) and of the truth in the law. KJV

**Rom 2:20** a corrector of the foolish, a teacher of the immature, having in the Law the embodiment of **knowledge** and of the truth, NASU

**Context:** Romans 2:17-29 The Jews and the Law

4)Romans 11:33 O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge(ST1108) of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! KJV

**Rom 11:33** Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and **knowledge** of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways! NASU

**Context:** Romans 11:25-36 All Israel Will Be Saved

5)Romans 15:14 And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge,(ST1108) able also to admonish one another. KJV

**Rom 15:14** And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all **knowledge** and able also to admonish one another. NASU

**Context:** Romans 15:14-21 Paul's Reason for Writing So Boldly

6)1 Corinthians 1:5 That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge;(ST1108) KJV

**1 Cor 1:5** that in everything you were enriched in Him, in all speech and all **knowledge**, NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 1:1-9 Salutation

**7-8-9-10**)1 Corinthians 8:1 Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge.(ST1108) Knowledge(ST1108) puffeth up, but charity edifieth. KJV

**1 Cor 8:1** Now concerning things sacrificed to idols, we know that we all have **knowledge**. **Knowledge** makes arrogant, but love edifies. NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 8:1-13 Food Offered to Idols

8)1 Corinthians 8:7 Howbeit there is not in every man that knowledge:(ST1108) for some with conscience of the idol unto this hour eat it as a thing offered unto an idol; and their conscience being weak is defiled. KJV

**1 Cor 8:7** However not all men have this **knowledge**; but some, being accustomed to the idol until now, eat food as if it were sacrificed to an idol; and their conscience being weak is defiled. NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 8:1-13 Food Offered to Idols

9)1 Corinthians 8:10 For if any man see thee which hast knowledge(ST1108) sit at meat in the idol's temple, shall not the conscience of him which is weak be emboldened to eat those things which are offered to idols; KJV

**1 Cor 8:10** For if someone sees you, who have **knowledge**, dining in an idol's temple, will not his conscience, if he is weak, be strengthened to eat things sacrificed to idols? NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 8:1-13 Food Offered to Idols

10)1 Corinthians 8:11 And through thy knowledge(ST1108) shall the weak brother perish, for whom Christ died? KJV

**1 Cor 8:11** For through your **knowledge** he who is weak is ruined, the brother for whose sake Christ died. NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 8:1-13 Food Offered to Idols

**11)**1 Corinthians 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge(ST1108) by the same Spirit; KJV

**1 Cor 12:8** For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of **knowledge** according to the same Spirit; NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 12:1-11 Spiritual Gifts

**12-13)**1 Corinthians 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge;(ST1108) and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. KJV

**1 Cor 13:2** If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all **knowledge**; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 13:1-13 The Gift of Love

**13)**1 Corinthians 13:8 Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge,(ST1108) it shall vanish away. KJV

**1 Cor 13:8** Love never fails; but if there are gifts of prophecy, they will be done away; if there are tongues, they will cease; if there is **knowledge**, it will be done away. NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 13:1-13 The Gift of Love

**14)**1 Corinthians 14:6 Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge,(ST1108) or by prophesying, or by doctrine? KJV

**1 Cor 14:6** But now, brethren, if I come to you speaking in tongues, what will I profit you unless I speak to you either by way of revelation or of **knowledge** or of prophecy or of teaching? NASU

**Context:** 1 Corinthians 14:1-25 Gifts of Prophecy and Tongues

**15)**2 Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge(ST1108) by us in every place. KJV

**2 Cor 2:14** But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and manifests through us the sweet aroma of the **knowledge** of Him in every place. NASU

**Context:** 2 Corinthians 2:12-17 Paul's Anxiety in Troas

**16)**2 Corinthians 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge(ST1108) of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. KJV

**2 Cor 4:6** For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the **knowledge** of the glory of God in the face of Christ. NASU

**Context:** 2 Corinthians 4:12-17 Paul's Anxiety in Troas

**17)**2 Corinthians 6:6 By pureness, by knowledge,(ST1108) by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned, KJV

**2 Cor 6:6** in purity, in **knowledge**, in patience, in kindness, in the Holy Spirit, in genuine love, NASU

**Context:** 2 Corinthians 5:11-6:13 The Ministry of Reconciliation

**18)**2 Corinthians 8:7 Therefore, as ye abound in every thing, in faith, and utterance, and knowledge,(ST1108) and in all diligence, and in your love to us, see that ye abound in this grace also. KJV

**2 Cor 8:7** But just as you abound in everything, in faith and utterance and **knowledge** and in all earnestness and in the love we inspired in you, see that you abound in this gracious work also. NASU

**Context:** 2 Corinthians 8:1-15 Encouragement to Be Generous

**19)**2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge(ST1108) of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; KJV

**2 Cor 10:5** We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the **knowledge** of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ, NASU

**Context:** 2 Corinthians 10:1-18 Paul Defends His Ministry

**20)**2 Corinthians 11:6 But though I be rude in speech, yet not in knowledge;(ST1108) but we have been thoroughly made manifest among you in all things. KJV

**2 Cor 11:6** But even if I am unskilled in speech, yet I am not so in **knowledge**; in fact, in every way we have made this evident to you in all things. NASU

**Context:** 2 Corinthians 11:1-15 Paul and the False Apostles

**21)**Ephesians 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge,(ST1108) that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. KJV

**Eph 3:19** and to know the love of Christ which surpasses **knowledge**, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God. NASU

**Context:** Ephesians 3:14-21 Prayer for the Readers

22)Philippians 3:8 Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge(ST1108) of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ, KJV

**Phil 3:8** More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of **knowing** Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ, NASU

**Context:** Philippians 3:1-11 Breaking with the Past

23)Colossians 2:3 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.(ST1108) KJV

**Col 2:3** in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and **knowledge**. NASU

**Context:** Colossians 1:24-2:5 Paul's Interest in the Colossians

24)1 Timothy 6:20 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science(ST1108) falsely so called: KJV

**1 Tim 6:20** O Timothy, guard what has been entrusted to you, avoiding worldly and empty chatter and the opposing arguments of what is falsely called "**knowledge**"— NASU

**Context:** 1 Timothy 6:20-21 Personal Instructions and Benediction

25)1 Peter 3:7 Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge,(ST1108) giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered. KJV

**1 Peter 3:7** You husbands in the same way, live with your wives in an **understanding** way, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered. NASU

**Context:** 1 Peter 3:1-7 Wives and Husbands

**26-27**)2 Peter 1:5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;(ST1108) KJV

**2 Peter 1:5** Now for this very reason also, applying all diligence, in your faith supply moral excellence, and in your moral excellence, **knowledge**, NASU

**Context:** 2 Peter 1:1-15 The Christian's Call and Election

27)2 Peter 1:6 And to knowledge(ST1108) temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; KJV

**2 Peter 1:6** and in your **knowledge**, self-control, and in your self-control, perseverance, and in your perseverance, godliness, NASU

**Context:** 2 Peter 1:1-15 The Christian's Call and Election

**28)** 2 Peter 3:18 But grow in grace, and in the knowledge(ST1108) of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen. KJV

**2 Peter 3:18** but grow in the grace and **knowledge** of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen. NASU

**Context:** 2 Peter 3:14-18 Final Exhortation and Doxology
