- 2) Why did Jesus urge the Jews to flee into the mountains?** *Ps. 24:3-5; Ps. 121:1,2*

- 3) Why in verse 22 did Jesus pronounce these were the days of vengeance on Israel?**
1 Thess. 2:14-16; Matt. 3:1,2,7-12; Luke 11:47-51

- 4) When in Israel’s history did the times of the Gentiles begin?**
Luke 21:24; Ezekiel 21:25-27; Lev. 26:14-18

- 5) Is there a connection in Daniel 9:26-27 and Jesus’ prophecy concerning the destruction of Jerusalem?**

- 6) Is there any spiritual fulfillment to these words of Jesus that can be applicable to the end of the Gospel Age?**
