- 1) What is the similarity of Jesus' return to the day of Noah in Luke 17:26-29?

- 2) 2 Thess. 2:10-12 speaks of strong delusions or deceptions in the last days of the Gospel Age. What might the purpose of these be? How can the new creation safeguard themselves from these delusions? *Luke 17:33-37; 2 Tim. 2:15; 1 Cor. 3:11-15; 2 Thess. 2:8-12*

- 3) In verse Matt. 24:6 it says that some will claim that Jesus is in *the secret chamber*. Has this, or will it, come about soon – and in what way(s)? *Psalms 24:3,4*

- 4) What are some ways that the very elect will know that these claims of Jesus being manifest here or there in the flesh (or materialized) are not genuine? *Acts 9:3-4; Luke 11:35-36*

- 5) How will or in what manner will Jesus be manifest to the saints and why? Is the answer contained, in part, in Matt. 24:27? How will this come about? *Luke 17:24,34-37; 1 John 3:2; Matt. 28:2-3*

- 6) Elaborate on how the Sun rises (Matt. 24:26) with Jesus' return. *1 Cor. 4:5; Luke 12:24*
What are the effects of that light on the world? Do we see that now? *2 Thess. 2:8; Eph. 5:13 KJV; Dan. 12:1*
