1. In the type, what was the significance and purpose of bringing the lamb into the home and then killing the lamb? *Exodus 12:3-7*

2. In the anti-type of the Passover, who or what did the lamb represent? Note: There are 3 main points to relate back to the type. *Exodus 12:3-7; Zechariah 9:9; John 12:12-19; John 1:29; Colossians 1:18; John 6:51; 1 Corinthians 5:7*

3. In the type, why was it that the Firstborn were subject to death? As a result of the Firstborn's faithfulness what happened to the nation of Israel? *Deuteronomy 21:15-17; Exodus 12:29-36; Psalm 105:36*

4. In the anti-type of the Passover, who do the firstborn represent? Today, what importance should be given to type and anti-type of the Passover by the followers of Christ and why? *Romans 8:29; Galatians 3:26-29; Psalm 110:4; Hebrews 7:11; 2 Corinthians 1:22; Romans 8:19; 1 Corinthians 5:7*
