<u>Kernel Point in Revelation 1:1-3</u> The <u>Revelation</u> of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to <u>shew</u> unto his <u>servants</u> things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and <u>signified</u> it by his <u>angel</u> unto his servant John: Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he <u>saw</u>. <u>Blessed is he</u> that <u>readeth</u>, and they that <u>hear</u> the words of this prophecy, and <u>keep those things which are written therein</u>: for the time is at hand.

Situation	Action Items	Revelation "Do" Scriptures Choices
Rev. 2:2-4	3 Items	Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. You hate the practices of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.
Rev. 2:9	1 Item	Do not be afraid of what you are about to suffer. I tell you, the devil will put some of you in prison to test you, and you will suffer persecution for ten days.
Rev. 2:20-21	5 Items	I know your deeds, your love and faith, your service and perseverance, and that you are now doing more than you did at first.
Rev. 2:24	1 Item	Hold on to what you have until I come.
Rev. 3:1-2	3 Items	Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; hold it fast, and repent.
Rev. 3:8-9	2 Items	You have kept my word and have not denied my name.
Rev. 3:15-17	1 Item	I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich; and white clothes to wear, so you can cover your shameful nakedness; and salve to put on your eyes, so you can see.
Rev. 13:8	1 Item	Whoever has ears, let them hear.
Rev. 14:1-3	3 Items	These are those who did not defile themselves with women, for they remained virgins. They follow the Lamb wherever he goes. No lie was found in their mouths; they are blameless.
Rev. 14:10-11	3 Items	This calls for patient endurance on the part of the people of God who keep his commands and remain faithful to Jesus.
Rev. 16:13-14	2 Items	Blessed is the one who stays awake and remains clothed, so as not to go naked and be shamefully exposed."
Rev. 18:2-3	1 Item	Come out of her, my people, so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plagues;
Rev. 19:4-7	2 Items	Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory!
