Verses one through ten of chapter 13 seem to be a set of final admonitions and reminders to the Corinthian brethren with a quick repetition of what Paul had already told them. This last chapter of 2nd Corinthians could serve as a review of some of the lessons Paul had taught the Corinthians in his two letters.

- Paul prays for their perfection Heb. 13:21; 1 Pet. 5:10; Luke 6:40
